Validity

This version comes into force on 31.08.2024. All previous versions lose their validity from this date.

Preliminary remarks

- Where terms refer to natural persons, both genders are meant in the singular and in the plural.
- Explanation of terms:
 - L.Ch. : Champion de Luxembourg de Beauté.
 - FCL : Fédération Cynologique Luxembourgeoise.
 - CACL : Certificat d'Aptitude au Champion de Luxembourg.
 - Centrale : Member of the FCL.
 - FCI : Fédération Cynologique Internationale.
 - Club : Dog club which is a member of a centrale or affiliated to a centrale.





Champion de Luxembourg de Beauté

Allocation of entitlements

The CACL are awarded to dogs and bitches with the form rating "excellent, 1st place" in the following classes:

- Intermediate class
- Working dog class
- Open class
- Champion class

The CACL Reserve is awarded analogously to the dogs with the form score "excellent, 2nd place".

The CACL and CACL reserve are valid indefinitely.

Titling

The title "Champion de Luxembourg de Beauté" (Lux Ch) is awarded by the Fédération Cynologique Luxembourgeoise (FCL), at the request of the owner, to the dog which:

- a) has acquired **two CACLs** at a pedigree dog show organized or approved by the FCL.
At least one CACL must be from an **international or national FCL dog show**.
- b) has been awarded the CACL **in the "Champion Class"** (only champion titles recognized by FCI and FCL) at an **international or national** dog show organized by the FCL.

The entitlements must have been acquired under different judges. The first CACL achieved is always recognised for the awarding of titles. It is not possible to choose which CACL is to be used for awarding the title.

A CACL reserve **can only be converted into a CACL at the request of** the owner of the dog that received the R-CACL, using the form provided, if one of the following **conditions is met:**

- a) The assigned CACL was canceled for some reason.
- b) The CACL is awarded to a dog that has already fulfilled the requirements for the L.Ch title on the day of the show.

This clause does not apply retroactively to the entry into force of this text.





Champion des Jeunes de Luxembourg de Beauté

Titling

On the day of the show, the judge can award the title 'Champion des Jeunes de Luxembourg de Beauté' to a male and a female that received a form score of "excellent, 1st place" in the junior class.

It should be noted that these titles can be awarded to males and females, in the specific breeds, be it coat or color, where a CACL is awarded in each case.

It is important to note that the judge does not necessarily have to award these titles.

Champion des Vétérans de Luxembourg de Beauté

Titling

On the day of the show, the judge can award the title 'Champion des Vétérans de Luxembourg de Beauté' to a male and a female that received the form score "excellent, 1st place" in the veteran class.

It should be noted that these titles can be awarded to males and females, in the specific breeds, be it coat or color, where a CACL is awarded in each case.

It is important to note that the judge does not necessarily have to award these titles.

Costs

The processing fee is 35 euros per title. The title will be sent as a pdf file by e-mail.

The printed version of the title will be sent by post for an additional charge of 15 euros.

If the application is not approved, a labour fee of 10 euros will be retained.

The processing fee for upgrading the CACL reserve to a full CACL is 10 euros.

The processing fee for upgrading the CACL reserve is non-refundable

Request title

The application for the champion title is made exclusively via OnlineDogShows.

The application for upgrading the CACL reserve is made exclusively via OnlineDogShows.

Duplicate title applications: Applications submitted and paid to the FCL by email or post before 31 August 2024 will not be refunded if submitted again via onlinedogshows.
